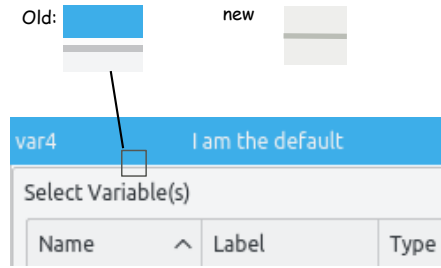


Currently (see right) the activated row is blue below is a gap (white), below that is a gray line, below that starts the lightgray background Which is a bit much separation, visually.

Suggestion: The option/row which is opened has a gray background (the closed ones are white) The gui for the options itself has a background of the same gray. They have no gap between, so it is clear that they belong together (a gray line of the like between the row makes sense though).

But any other appearance is o.k. as long as
- the activated row looks different than an not-activated/closed row and has the same background as the background of the Interface for the options-to-be-changed



space for the column with the triangle to indicate opened/closed options.

Indicator that these options/row can be extended and closed again. For a currently closed one it's arrow down for a opened one its arrow up.
